Opening Doors' Enhanced Services for Asylees and Vulnerable Noncitizens Program (ESAVN) provides culturally appropriate and responsive case management services to asylees and vulnerable noncitizens

Program Eligibility

- Individuals who have been recently granted asylum
- Those preparing to file or have filed petitions for T-Visa or U-Visa
- Noncitizen victims of human trafficking, domestic violence, and other serious crimes

Eligibility timeline

- 90 days within the first year following the grant of asylum
- Having been deemed vulnerable and eligible for services

Benefits application assistance

• SSN, Medi-Cal, Cal Fresh, Cal Works and other eligible programs.



Cultural Orientation

• Provide cultural orientation and integration programs to help navigate the American system and get the tools needed to become self-reliant.



English Language Development

Assist with enrollment in English language program for adults.



School Enrollment

Assist with meeting school requirements and enrollment for children.



Employment/Training

 Assist with enrollment in employment services, job counseling, and placement/training programs.



General Case Management

 Assist in resource navigation and appropriate cultural community connections.
