Preferred Communities Program Support for Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolees



Opening Doors' Preferred Communities Program assists eligible Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolees (UHPs) with intake, assessment, and referrals for needed benefits and services for 90 days from the date of their enrollment. The program is designed to ensure that basic needs are met, immediate challenges are addressed, and important steps towards self-sufficiency are taken.

Program Eligibility

Citizens or nationals of Ukraine, or non-Ukrainians who last habitually resided in Ukraine and were paroled into the U.S on or after February 24, 2022.





Program Services

- Assistance applying for Social Security card
- Assistance applying for public benefits (SNAP, CalWorks, MediCal)
- Assistance applying for an Employment Authorization Document (EAD)
- Assistance with enrolling children in school
- Facilitating access to English classes and (employment opportunities)
- Facilitating access to health care
- Facilitating access to housing and basic necessities
