



FURNITURE TRANSPORTATION SUPPORT VOLUNTEER (WV)

Refugee Resettlement

Scope of Work: Complete furniture donation pickups at residences and businesses throughout the greater Sacramento region.

As a furniture transportation support volunteer, you will support moving furniture to and from donors' homes to the apartment or house of the intended recipient. Please note that some furniture donations may be dropped off at our storage units.

Additionally, during pickups and deliveries, you will be joined by another volunteer, the volunteer coordinator, or a case manager.

During some instances, you may be requested to help assemble furniture upon delivery. This will be communicated beforehand.

Time Commitment: As a furniture transportation support volunteer, we request support with at least one furniture pickup and delivery a month over the span of three months.

There are no set dates or times, the volunteer coordinator will reach out on an as needed basis.

- Responsible for the pick-up and delivery of furniture from the donor's residence to the storage units and/or client's home
- Ability to effectively communicate the mission and values of Opening Doors with donors
- When requested, help assemble furniture for clients upon delivery

Requirements

- Strong intercultural communications skills, demonstrated ability to work effectively with people from diverse backgrounds and across language barriers.
- Willingness to adhere to ODI's volunteer and workplace policies
- Must have access to reliable transportation with ample cargo space
- Ability to navigate throughout the Sacramento region
- Ability to lift heavy items such as couches, dining room tables, etc.
